



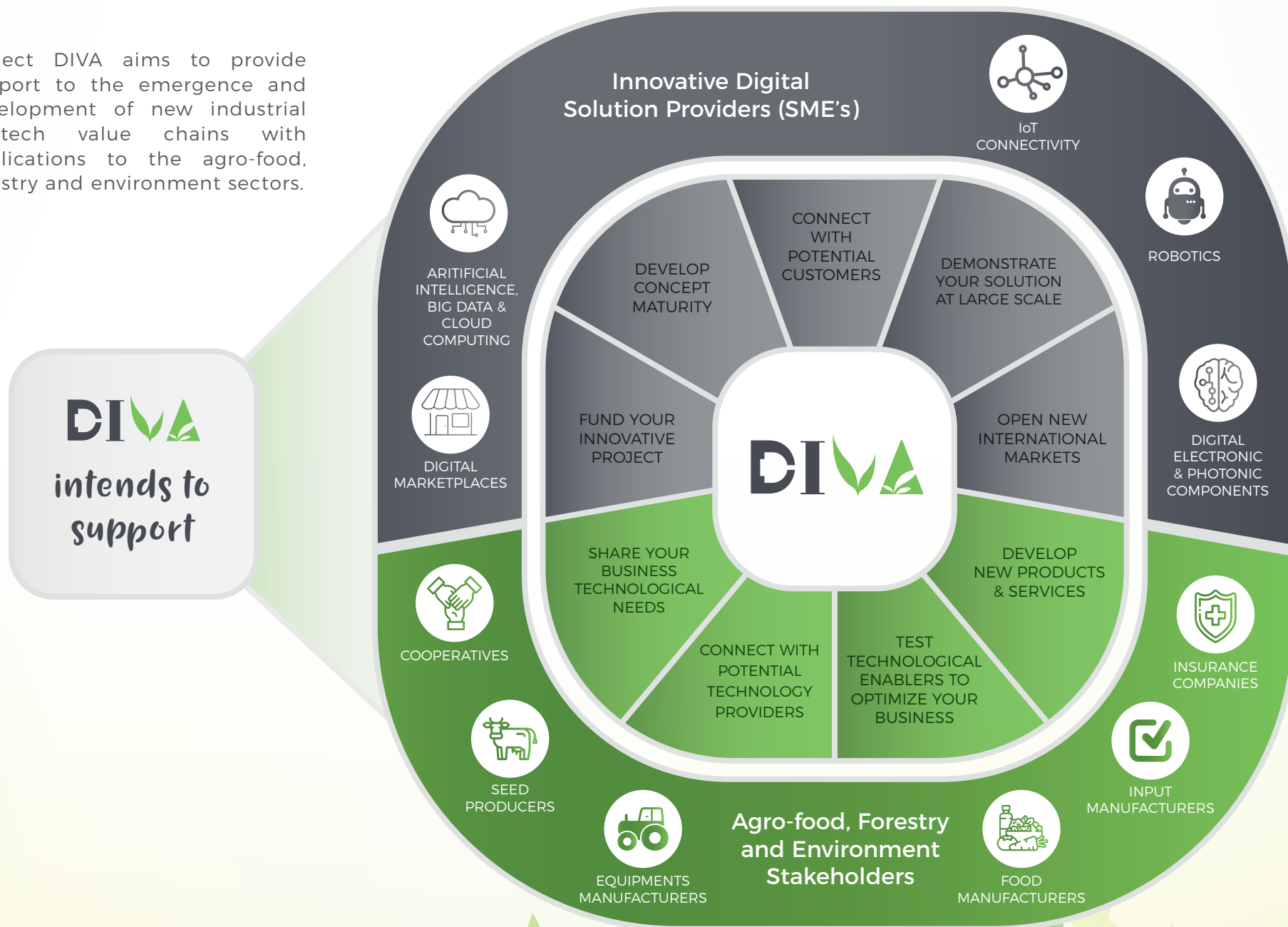

### CALL FOR CHALLENGE

For those who have a problem to solve and want to work with innovative SMEs. Submit your challenge.



### DEMONSTRATION SITE NETWORK

For those who wish to provide pilot sites, plots, production units, etc. to host demonstration of innovative solutions.

Two selective calls for projects with nearly €3 million in budget will be launched to fund the best innovative solutions by SMEs through several innovation vouchers reaching up to €60k:

€10 K



### COACHING AND MENTORING

Funds the expertise and advice of a third party to accelerate the innovation process.

€10 K



### MATURATION

Funds the technological maturation work of the SME and/or the expertise of a third party.

€25 K - €60 K



### DEMONSTRATION

Funds the demonstration of the solution in a live environment or in near-real conditions.

€30 K



### INTERNATIONALISATION

Funds any external expertise required in the value-chain internationalisation process, as well as attendance to international fairs and events.

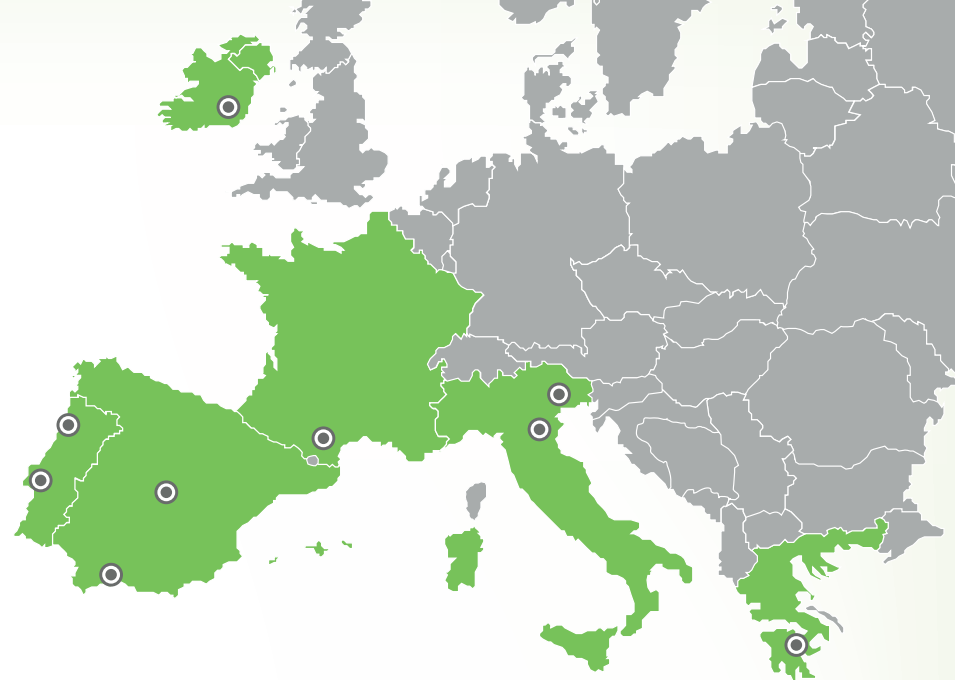
